ISMICC was authorized by the 21st Century Cures Act to improve quality of care for adults and children with mental health conditions. For the first time, a federal committee on mental health is reporting directly to the Secretary of Health and Human Services.

A new Assistant Secretary for Mental Health and Substance Use is established.

Role of the Committee

Summarize advances in the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of mental health conditions in children and adults.

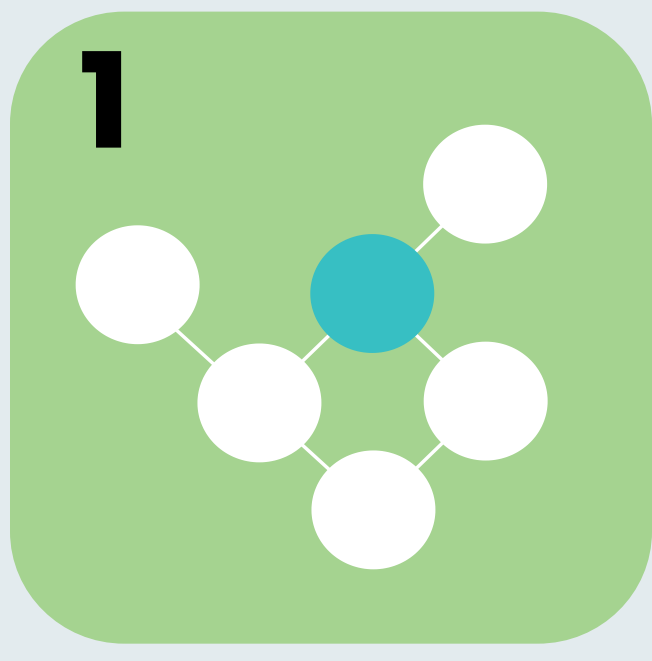
Evaluate the public health impact of federal programs on serious mental illnesses.

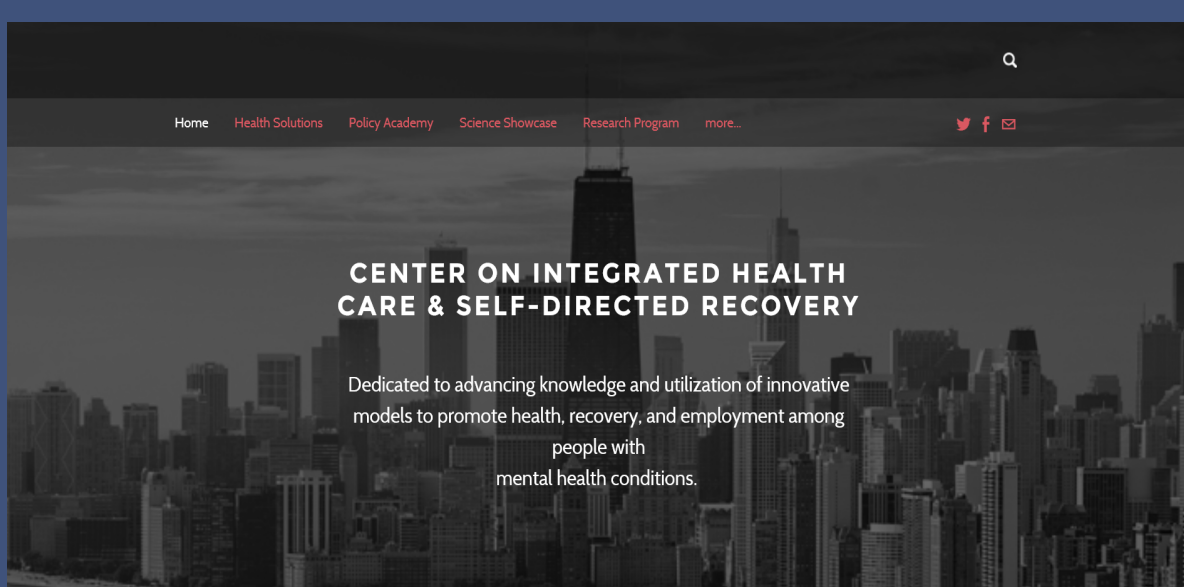
